 I will warrant & defend the same to the said Lewis & Clarke
 his heirs and assigns against all lawful claims & demands
 of any person or persons whatsoever either in Law or Equity
 for Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed
 my seal this 28th day of October AD 1846
