 second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth
 bargain & sell unto the said party of the second part
 and to his heirs and assigns forever all and —
 singular the North West quarter of the North East
 quarter of Section Seventeen Township 22 Range one
 East in the Muscalosa Land district together with
 all and singular the tenements & appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in any wise belonging and
 reversion and reversions remainders rents issues & profits
 thereof and also all the estate right and title interest
 and claim or demand whatsoever of him the said
 party of the first either in Law or Equity of in & to the
 above bargained premises and every part and parcel
 thereof to have and to hold the same to the said party
 of the second part his heirs and assigns to the sole
 and only proper use and benefit of the said party
 of the second his heirs and assigns forever in
 Witness whereof I have hereunto set my own hand
 and seal the day and date as Wrote above
