 I now have in my possession but this deed is an act
 for the following purpose and trust and for no other
 purpose that is to say I am indebted to one D. M. Mosby
 for which I made to him said John D. West an —
 promissory note bearing date the day of — and made
 payable 25th December 1847 for the sum of one
 hundred & twenty dollars and although said note
 was signed by myself & John D. West to the said —
 John D. West was nothing more than my security to
 said note and I am desirous to secure and make
 certain the payment of the said note if I should
 pay the said debt and save the said John D. West
 from its payment or any part thereof thus this —
 Deed to the said but if I should not then the
 said John D. West as trustee after giving two days
 notice in writing at the Court House door of said
 County may expose the said buggy & harness to sale
 publicly to the highest bidder for cash and
 appropriate the proceeds first to the repay expenses
 and cost say to the satisfaction of said note and
 then to pay the balance if any then be to one —
 given under my hand and seal this 21st day of
 January 1848 A. M. Colwell (Seal)
