 County of Shelly and named as follows to Wit

the North East Quarter of Section seventeen Township
 twenty one Range one East to have and to hold the
 above granted & above described land with the tenem-
 ents & privileges & appurtenances therunto belonging
 in any wise appertaining unto him the said Willie
 & Dope party of the second part his heirs and
 assigns for ever and we the said Abel K. Williams
 and Margaret Williams husband and wife parties
 of the first part do covenant and agree with the said
 party of the second part his heirs and assigns that
 we and Lawfully seized of the above granted premises
 that they are free from all incumbrances that we have
 a good right to sell and convey the same in manner
 aforesaid and that we will forever warrant and
 defend the title in fee simple to the above granted premises
 to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns
 against the lawful claims and demands of any and
 every other person whatever in witness of all which we
 have set our hands and seals this 29th day of January
 1848
