 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have
 given granted bargained and sold and by these
 presents do give grant bargain and sell to the said
 party of the second part the following described Land
 lying and being in the County of Shelby and State
 aforesaid to-wit and described as follows to-wit
 East half of the South East quarter of Section seven
 West half of the South West quarter of Section eight
 Also thirty five acres lying in the North East quarter
 of the South West quarter of Section eight also forty
 five acres lying in the South end of the South East
 quarter of Section eight all in Township No twenty
 two Range Three West to have and hold said
 Land and premises with the tenements and appurtenances
 thereto belonging and we the said party of the first
 part do covenant to and with the said party of the
 second part that we and lawfully seized of the
 premises aforesaid and that we have good right to
 bargain and sell the same in manner and form
 aforesaid and that we together with our heirs with
 forever warrant and defend titles in fee simple to
 said Land to said party of the second part from
 us our heirs and those claiming under us and also
 against the government of the United States or
 any person of which Witness my hand and seal
 the day and year aforesaid
