 Do I do a trust This deed of trust made and entered  
 John D. West into this 14<sup>th</sup> day of March 1848 -  
 between Wyatt Green and John D. West both of said  
 County and State witnesseth that the said Green and  
 West have this day executed to Hancock Carter a  
 promissory note of even date with this deed of trust  
 for the sum of sixty dollars on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of January  
 1848 upon which note the said West is and the security  
 of the said Green now is and to secure the said  
 West from loss by signing said note as my security  
 and for the further consideration of one dollar to  
 me in hand paid by the said West the receipt  
 of which is hereby acknowledged the said  
 Green have this day bargained sold and by  
 these presents do bargain and sell to the said West  
 a certain dark bay or brown colored mare about  
 eight or nine years old in trust however upon  
 the following conditions to wit if the said Green should  
 pay the said note or cause it to be paid for me or  
 as by the day it falls due as above stated and save the  
 said West harmless from any liability on said  
 note after its falls due then this deed of trust it is  
 to be void of no force but should I fail to pay  
 said note by the time it falls due then the said  
 West upon given ten days notice at Columbiana  
 in said County may seize and sell said mare to the highest  
 bidder for cash and apply the proceeds of sale to the  
 payment of said note or enough thereof to satisfy said  
 note and the costs of this deed of trust and the  
 balance if any pay over to me the said Green  
 witness and seal and seal the date first above  
 written
