 day bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents
 doth bargain sell & convey unto the said Gasaway
 & Hand all that tract or parcel of Land lying
 and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama
 as known as the north east fourth of the North West
 fourth of section twenty eighth Township Twenty one
 Range two West containing forty acres more or less
 in the district of Land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa
 Alabama which tract or parcel of Land with
 all and singular the appurtenances hereunto in
 right in any wise appertaining unto the said Gasaway
 & Hand his heirs and assigns forever and the said
 James C. Hand for himself his heirs Executors and
 Administrators doth warrant and defend the right title
 to the above described and hereby conveyed premises
 unto the said Gasaway & Hand his heirs and assigns
 forever against the claims of himself the said James
 C. Hand and all and every other person or persons
 claiming or holding
 Indemnity whereof the said James C. Hand have
 hereunto set my hand and seal this day & year
 above written James C. Hand
