This indenture made and entered into this 3rd day of June
1848 between Buckner Walls debtor of the first part and John
McClanahan Trustee of the second part and James B Jolley
Creditor of the third part all of the County of Shelby and
State of Alabama. Witnesseth that whereas the said Jolley
is bound as the security for the said Walls in the sum
of fifty one dollars in a judgment and cast against
them in favor of Ephraim Rinehart had before George
Harris Justice of the peace in and for said County on the
4th day of March 1848 for said amount and the said party
of the first part being desirous to secure the said party of
the third part against said liability has sold and the said
Walls party of the first part hereby far and in consideration
of said liability and the further sum of one dollar to the
said party of the first part in hand paid by the said
party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged bargains sells and conveys to the said party
of the second part the entire cotton crop now in
cultivation by said Walls say nine acres and three cows
and calves to have and to hold in trust as follow to wit
it is agreed by the parties that if the said party of the
first part shall pay to the said party of the third part
the said sum of fifty one dollars or otherwise release the
same from liability thereon by the first day of January
next then this indenture to be null and void but on
defauult to pay as aforesaid the said party of the second part
is hereby authorized to sell for cash the said cotton crop and
cows &c after giving thirty days notice and out of the proceeds
to pay said debt and the balance if any to said Walls given
under our hands and seals this day and date above
