Oath of Identity

State of Alabama } On this 28th day of Aug in the year
and County of Shelby } one thousand eight hundred and
forty eight personally appeared before me the undersigned
a justice of the peace for the county and state above
mentioned James H. Gillsby who being duly sworn
according to Law declares that he is the identical James
H. Gillsby who was a private in the Company commanded
by Captain John E. Barr in the first Battalion -
Alabama Vol, commanded by Lt. Col, J. J. Sibley that he
enlisted on the 25th day of November 1847 for the term during
the war and was discharged at Mobile Alabama
on the 28th day of June 1848 by reason of being mustered
out of service on the expiration of his term
known to and subscribed before me the day and year
above written Herano Sumner
