according to Law declares that he is the identical John
B Loomis who was a first sergeant in the company
commanded by Capt. John G Davis in the first Battalion
Alabama Volunteers commanded by Lieut. Col J. H. Seale
that he enlisted on the 25th day of Nov. 1847 for the
term during the War and was discharged at Mobile
Alabama on the 28th day of June by reason of
being Mustered out of service on account of the
expiration of his term
