 the premises rented by said Hatcher from William
 Davis to have and to hold unto the said Lewis

Barndon his heirs & assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that if the said Demary Hatcher shall by the first day of January next (1st day 1849) pay said L Barndon the above specified \$7.16 with interest thereon thirty Dollars to the said Robert Pitts & twenty dollars to said William L. Pruntice by the first of January next so the said Barndon shall be entirely released from the payment of either of said debts without cost or damage to him said Barndon then the said property to be the property of said Hatcher but if default be made in the payment of either of said debts then the said Lewis Barndon is hereby acknowledged to sell said property at Montreal or at public sale for cash giving ten days notice by advertisement out of the proceeds of said sale pay the said several debts the rest of the Land & also costs and expenses attending this conveyance and the remainder pay over to the said Hatcher
