To } Deed of Gift } Be it remembered that on the thirteenth
Barthema Ogle } day of July one Thousand Eight hundred
and forty eight that by Cross has this day gifted unto
Barthema Ogle for the respect that the said Cross has
for her & her heirs the following property (to wit) one
negro woman named Ann one girl named Gady one
fire named Uria Three head of horses Eighteen head
of cattle five beds & furniture & written furniture one
wagon fifty head of hogs and all other property that
was transferred from or by Gilbert Ogle unto the
said by Cross it being the property that once belonged
to the estate of Eli Cross dec'd and the said Cross
doth for himself his heirs &c. Transfer all his right
title and interest of said property unto the said
Barthema Ogle to have and hold for her own use
and benefit alone - In Testimony whereof I have
here unto set my hand & name and affixed my seal
day and year first above written by Cross Seal
