

Whereas I Nathan I Norris of Shelby County Alabama
am indebted to Lewis Bowdon and Aaron I Gamble in the
sum of Three hundred and thirty four dollars and thirty
eight Cents to the payment of which sum I am willing and
anxious to secure Now know all men by these presents
that in consideration of the premises and for the further
consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by said
Lewis Bowdon and Aaron I Gamble the receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge have and by these presents do
certain sell & convey unto the said Lewis Bowdon &
Aaron I Gamble the following described lands to wit
the west half of the South West Quarter of section fifteen
Township Twenty Range Three West also the south East
fourth of the North West fourth except a part thereof
lying North of Buck Creek now inclosed by the lands
of Moses G Fields extending to the branch West of the
North & South line in the same section Township and
Range last mentioned also the following property viz
a York of cotton & carry by to have & to hold the same
unto the said Lewis Bowdon & Aaron I Gamble their
heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever
Upon trust nevertheless that if the said Nathan I
Norris shall by the first day of January 1850 pay or
cause to be paid to the said Lewis Bowdon & Aaron
I Gamble the above specified sum 304 28 then the
said land and property to be the property of said
Norris but if default be made in the payment of
any part of said debt then the said Lewis Bowdon
& Aaron I Gamble are hereby authorized to sell said
land property at Montevallo at public sale for cash
giving ten days notice by advertisement out of the
proceeds of said sale pay the said debt and all
costs & expenses attending this conveyance and the
remainder pay over to said Norris
