 deed of trust to } I Charles Briggs of the County of
 Henry Harlep } Shelby State of Alabama being anxious
 to secure Henry Harlep for two hund-
 red and fifty dollars for which I have this day given him
 my promissory note due the first day of January next do
 hereby bargain and sell unto the said Henry Harlep a
 certain negro woman slave named Jane about 28 years old
 to have & to hold the said female negro slave & her future
 increase to the said Henry Harlep his heirs & assigns
 forever. In trust always that the said woman shall
 remain in my possession free of hire untill the said
 note becomes due then upon failure on my part or
 my heirs or to pay & satisfy said note & the charges -

hiron the said Henry Harlep is authorized to sell said
 woman at the dwelling house of the said Harlep after ten
 days notice by advertisement to the highest bidder for
 cash pay himself the full amount of said note the
 interest & charges hereon & the balance pay to me - but if
 said note & charges are promptly paid within due time
 this obligation to be void &c.
