 Popper's lot & the road and whereas the adms of said
 McCormick has made payment in full to the party
 of the 1st part for said land wherefor for and in
 consideration of said payment by virtue of the
 authority in us vested under said will we said
 Executrix & Executors have given Granted conveyed
 and sold and by these Presents do Give Grant
 convey and sell to said heirs aforesaid the lot aforesaid
 to have & hold forever and we will forever
 warrant & defend titles in fee simple to said lot and
 premises as Executors & Executrix aforesaid forever witness
 our hands & seals
