said David M McClanahan his heirs and assigns forever upon trust
nevertheless and the condition following That the said Henry Shrader
shall be permitted to hire out said negroes at public outcry in the
County of Shelby to the highest bidder taking notes with good security
for the payment of such hire untill the Expiration of said final
close of said administration with this Exception That the
Henry Shrader be permitted to take to his house in Galadago

County subject to the other conditions of this trust then of said negroes to wit. Richard Packard and Nathaniel. And upon this further trust that in the event the said parties of the third part become liable for any amount of money by reason of their said securityship on said administration bond then the said trustee upon being required by the said parties of the third part shall after giving thirty days notice of the time and place of sale proceed to sell at the Court house in the town of Columbiana for cash enough of said property to satisfy and pay off all such liability or liabilities of said securities and the balance over if any shall pay to the said Henry Shrader.

And in the event that the said Henry Shrader shall well and truly discharge his duties as such administrator and shall save his said securities harmless in all respects in the premises then this deed to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue - In testimony whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date above written.
