 of section 29 Township 19 Range 2 East containing 80 acres  
 be the same more or less together with all & singular incidents  
 -ments & appurtenances & appurtenances hereto belonging or  
 in anywise appertaining & the Reversion & Reversions Remain-  
 -ed & Remainders & Parts & parts herof herof herof &  
 all the Estate Right Title Interest property claim & demand  
 whatsoever of him the said Burchfield of in and to the said  
 Land & Tenements & premises & of in to every part & parcel thereof  
 of with their & every of their appurtenances to have & to hold the  
 said Land Tenements hereditaments & all & singular the  
 premises hereby granted and confirmed as mentioned  
 or intended so to be with their & every of their appurtenances  
 unto the said Elizabeth G Duke her heirs & assigns to the only  
 proper use & behoof of her said Elizabeth G Duke her  
 heirs & assigns for ever & the said E Burchfield for himself  
 his heirs Executors & administrators doth covenant Grant  
 & agree to & with the said Elizabeth G Duke her heirs &  
 assigns shall & lawfully may from time to time & at all times  
 hereafter peaceably & quietly lawfully use occupy possess &
