 and State aforesaid. It witnesseth that the party of the first part for  
 and in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars to  
 them in hand paid by the party of the second part the receipt  
 whereof whereof is hereby acknowledged have received and sold  
 and by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the said  
 party of the said second part the following described tract of  
 parcel of land situated lying and being in the county of Shelby  
 the west south west fourth of the south east fourth of section  
 eight township 19 Range 2 west containing 39 97/100 acres  
 and all that part of the S E half of the south east  
 1/4 of section 8 township 19 Range 2 west that is lying -  
 south west of the Spring branch three acres more or  
 less and also the N W 1/4 of the N E 1/4 of section 8 of T 19 of  
 Range two west containing eight acres also the S E 1/4  
 of S E 1/4 of S 8 T 19 R 2 west containing 39 97/100 acres  
 and also the N W 1/4 of the S E 1/4 of S 8 T 19 R 2 west  
 containing 39 97/100 acres all lying and being in the  
 Tuscaloosa Land District to have and to hold the above  
 bargained land and premises together with all and  
 singular the hereditaments and appurtenances there  
 unto belonging unto the said Nedham Acton and  
 Thomas Bailey Junr their heirs and assigns forever  
 and the said party of the first part do hereby  
 bind themselves their heirs executors and administrato  
 ritors to warrant and protect to defend the  
 above bargained premises unto the said second  
 party their heirs and assigns forever against all  
 claims whatsoever in the like manner whereby  
 the said party of the first part have been unto  
 set their hands and seals the day and year  
 first above mentioned
