John P West one Black horse four years old  
to have and to hold. It is agreed by the said  
J P West that the said Deft Holcombe shall  
have the use of the said horse until the  
25<sup>th</sup> day of December next and also agreed that  
if the said Deft Holcombe shall pay to him  
the said John P West Forty Seven Dollars  
with Lawful interest therefrom 21<sup>st</sup> day of  
February Last by the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December next  
then in that event to sell to him the said  
horse but in default of the said Deft Holcombe  
to pay the said Forty Seven Dollars & interest  
as aforesaid by the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December next that the  
said West is to take said horse without sale or  
otherwise for closing this deed given under  
my hand and seal this day and date
