

This deed closed by the parties by absolute sale of the property herein contained this 17th day of Dec 1849 Edward G. Flory

Flory - This indenture made the 10th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine between Edward G. Flory of the first part and Lewis Pintell of the 2nd part both of the County of Shelby and State of Alabama whereas the said Edward G. Flory in and by certain obligations or writings obligatory under his hand and seal bearing even date herewith stands bound unto the said Lewis Pintell in the sum of two thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars conditioned for the full and entire payment of the same on the twenty-fifth day of December A.D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty one with lawful interest for the same as in and by the recited obligation & conditions thereof relation being thereunto had more fully and at large appears

Now this indenture witnesseth that the said Edward G. Flory as will per & in consideration of the aforesaid debt or sum of money and for the better securing the payment thereof with its interest unto the said Lewis Pintell his executors administrators and assigns in discharge of the said recited obligation as of the further sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Lewis Pintell at and before the signing and delivery hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Lewis Pintell his heirs and assigns all of the following property to wit: One negro man Jim one negro woman Adelaide one woman Mary and Chitarr one boy Liff Girl Elizabeth Lelia Louisa and one boy Casly To have and hold the said property here by granted or mentioned intended so to be unto the said Lewis Pintell his heirs and assigns a pious to the only proper use and behoof of the said Lewis Pintell his heirs and assigns forever provided always notwithstanding that if the said Edward G. Flory his heirs executors or administrators shall and do will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Lewis Pintell his executors administrators or assigns the aforesaid debt or sum of two thousand seven hundred and fifty dollars on the day & time herein before mentioned and appointed for the payment thereof with lawful interest for the same according to the condition of the said recited obligation without any fraud or further delay deduction defalcation or abatement to be made of any thing for or in respect of any taxes charges whatsoever then and from thence forth as will this present
