 sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell
 unto the said party of the second part and his heirs
 and assigns forever all that Tract or parcel of Land
 whereon the said party of the second part now lives
 consisting of and being the South West Quarter of
 Fractional Section Six of Township twenty one of range
 two east in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Ala-
 bama containing seventy nine and $\frac{9}{10}$ Acres together
 with all and singular the hereditaments and appur-
 tenances thereto ^{now} belonging as in any more appertain-
 ing and also all the Estate right Title claim and
 interest whatsoever of him the said party of the first
 part Either Law or Equity of in and to the above bar-
 gained premises and parcel thereof. He have and to
 hold to the said party of the second part his heirs
 and assigns to the sole and only proper use and
 benefit and behoof of the said party of the second
 part his heirs and assigns forever In witness
