 hundred & forty nine between Lepton Quinn of the first part
 Johnathan Gilchrist William Vick & John G. Watton Trustees
 for Liberty Church in said County and their successors
 as such of the second part Witnesseth that the party
 of the first part for and in consideration of the sum
 of five dollars to him in hand paid by the party of the
 2nd part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as well for
 and in consideration of his love for the Church has given gra-
 -nted bargained and sold and by these presents does
 Give Grant bargain sell Convey & convey to the said
 party of the 2nd part & their successors two acres of land
 lying and being a part of the N¹/₂ N¹/₂ Section No 2 Town-
 -ship 20 Range one west and more particularly descri-
 -bed as follows to wit and also covering said meeting-house
 Liberty to the best advantage and the other also covering
 said burying ground to the best advantage to have and
 to hold said land and premises to said party of the
 2nd part and their successors to be from time to time
 appointed by said Church Liberty from me the said
 party of the 1st part and for my heirs so long as said
 Church continues its present location and to the land
 covering said burying ground for ever and I the said
 party of the 1st part do covenant to and with the party
 of the 2nd part that I will forever warrant and defend
 titles in fee simple to said land and premises to said
 party of the 2nd part as trustees as aforesaid and to
 their successors as such in testimony of which
 Witness my hand and seal the day and year
 aforesaid
