 Chilton County } into this 13th day of September in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and forty nine between Hugh Stinson and Joseph
 Roper both of the County aforesaid Witnesseth that the said
 Hugh Stinson is justly indebted to the said Joseph Roper
 in the following sums and in the following manner to wit
 In the sum of seventeen dollars and twenty five cents
 with interest from 20 March 1849 made payable by note on
 the first day of January next after the date of said note
 In the sum of forty five dollars and seventy three cents
 and interest from first day of January 1849 it being the
 balance due on a note made by said Hugh Stinson to
 G W Munnally and by him sold to the said Joseph Roper
 In the sum of fifteen dollars the amount due on a note
 made by the said Hugh Stinson to McFlanahan & Harris
 and by them assigned to the said Joseph Roper which said
 sums of money the said Hugh Stinson is desirous to secure
 therefore for and in consideration of the promises as well as
 the sum of five dollars to him in hand paid by the said
 Hugh Stinson the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 the said Hugh Stinson has given granted bargained and
 sold and does by these presents give grant bargain and sell
 to the said Joseph Roper the following property to wit a
 yoke of oxen and a wagon and twenty head of his most
 valuable hogs to have and to hold unto the said
 and it is hereby expressly agreed and understood that the
 said Joseph Roper is to indulge the said Hugh Stinson
 until the first day of January next for said sums of
 money and interest and permit the said Hugh Stinson
 to enjoy the uninterrupted possession of said property
 until the first of January 1850 And then should the said
 Hugh Stinson fail to pay said Joseph Roper the said
 sums of money with lawful interest and all such costs
 and may accrue in and about this deed and the
 sale of said property then the said Joseph Roper may

shall at his pleasure advertise and sell said property to the highest bidder after having given ten days notice of the time and place of said by public advertisement at 3 or more public places in said County and out of the proceeds of said sale pay said debts and costs above secured and the balance if any pay over to the said Hugh Stinson In testimony whereof witnesses our hands and seals the day and year above written
