 of the second part all my right and title interest
 and claim of all the following tract or parcel of
 land known and distinguished by being the North East
 fraction of section 18 Township 22 Range 2 East in the two
 -calosa land district containing one hundred and
 twenty acres on the following express condition whereas the
 said John Wozz greatly indebted to the said Abraham
 Smith in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars
 due by a promissory note due the 25th day of December
 1865 and one other note due the 25th December 1867 for
 two hundred dollars now if the said John Wozz fails
 to pay to the said Abraham Smith or his certain
 attorney the whole amount according to Contract and
 in case the said John Wozz fails to pay the said a
 mounts when due in that case if John Wozz do
 authorize and empower the said Abraham Smith of the
 second part to advertise the above described property
 30 days at three or more public places and sell
 the same and in case the same is sold to sell the
 same for cash pay and satisfy said notes and cost
 the over plus if any to go to the benefit of said
 Wozz and in case the land is sold I do in the
 presence of this witness I do hereby authorize and
 constitute and appoint Abraham Smith my
 lawful agent and attorney or agent to make a
 good and lawful title to the above described land
 in my name which I do acknowledge shall be as
 binding on me as if done personally by myself
