 of the second part all of the County and State aforesaid
 Witnesseth that the part of the first part for and in consideration
 of the sum of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars
 to them in hand paid by the said Elizer Simpson before
 the signing sealing and delivering hereof the receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged the said part of the first
 part have given granted bargained & sold and by these
 presents do give grant bargain and sell to the said
 party of the second part the following tract of Land
 Lying & being in said County and known as follows to
 wit $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE quarter of section No 29 in Township No 21 of
 Range No 1 W containing 39 Aers and 98 $\frac{1}{2}$ hundredths to
 have and hold said land and premises to said Elizer
 Simpson and to his heirs forever and now the said
 party of the second part that we are lawfully seized
 of the premises aforesaid that we have given right to
 bargain and sell the land and premises aforesaid

and that we will forever warrant and defend titles in
 fee simple to said land to said Elazer Simpson and
 his heirs forever against the Claims & demands of the Govern-
 =ment of the United States and of every other person in
 testimony of which we have hereunto set our hands and
 seals the day & year above written
