 husband and wife have given granted bargained
 and sold and by these presents do Give Grant
 bargain and sell to the heirs of said Frederick Sittis
 the land aforesaid to wit the NW¹/₂ of NW¹/₄ section 13
 Township 22 Range 2 West to have and hold the same
 forever and we do Covenant to and with said heirs
 that we will give warrant & defend title in fee
 simple for said Land to said heirs

hereby acknowledged before the sealing and delivering these
present to hath bargained sold and conveyed and by these
present to doth bargain sell and convey unto the said
David Forest his heirs and assigns the East half of the
South west fourth of section Thirty five Township
Twenty one of Range Three West also the south west
fourth of the North East fourth of the same section
and Township and Range containing one hundred and twenty
acres more or less Township lying and being in the District
of Land subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama together
with all and singular the Rights members and appurten
ances therunto belonging of the above described Land
to the said David Forest his heirs and assigns to them
and their poster benefit and behoof forever in fee simple and
the said John B and Martha M. will forever warrant
and defend the right and title of the above described Land
to the said David Forest his heirs and assigns forever
themselves their heirs Executors and administrators and from
all and every other person or persons whatsoever for ever
in testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands
and affixed our seals the day and date above written
