we do hereby acknowledge have bargained sold and conveyed &
 by these presents do bargain sell and convey unto the said
 David McElanahan a certain tract or parcel of Land
 lying and being in Shelby County & State of Alabama and
 known as the North East fourth of the North West fourth
 of Section Two Township 22 & Range 1 West Containing 40 acres
 more or less in the County and State aforesaid to have and
 to hold the said Land and premises with appurtenances
 therunto belonging unto him the said David McElanahan
 his heirs and assigns forever & we the said George Crawford
 & Obedience Crawford his wife George & Crawford & Mary
 Crawford his wife for ourselves our and each of our heirs
 executors and Administrators do covenant to and with the
 said David McElanahan his heirs Executors Administrators
 and assigns that at and until the sealing hereof we
 are lawfully seized of the premises and that we have good
 right to bargain & sell the same in manner & form aforesaid
 & that we will warrant and defend the same to the said
 David McElanahan his heirs and assigns against all lawful
 claims and demands of any person or persons whomsoever
 either in law or Equity in witness whereof we have hereunto set
 our hands and affixed our seals this the 22 day of July
 1848
