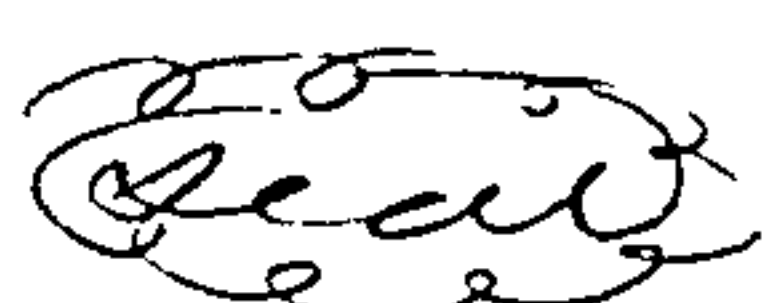


This indenture made and entered into this the 6th day
 of December A D 1849 between L D Doak and his wife
 Lucinda Doak of the first part and John B Wilson
 & John Sumner of the second part witnesseth that
 whereas the said J B Wilson & John Sumner have
 indorsed for the said L D Doak a certain prom-
 issory note for the sum of six hundred and 15⁰⁰
 dollars payable to M J Horton Executor of the last
 will and Testament of Thos Smith dec'd twelve
 months after date and dated the 6th day of Decem-
 ber A D 1849 and the said L D Doak and Lucinda
 Doak wife of the said L D Doak being desirous to
 secure and save harmless the said J B Wilson
 & John Sumner against all response lettes as
 endorsers of the said note aforesaid Therefore
 this indenture witnesseth that the said L D Doak
 and Lucinda Doak as well for and in con-
 sideration of securing said Endorsers from the payment
 of the note aforesaid as the further sum of one
 dollar to them in hand paid the receipt is
 hereby acknowledged that Granted bargain
 and sold confirmed and by these presents doth
 Grant bargain sell release and confirmed unto

the said J B Wilson and John Sumner their
 heirs and assigns all right title claim and
 interest which they have in and to the following
 property viz And negro Girl named Mary and
 her two children about 12 years old and
 one free horse wagon to have and to hold the
 said property hereby granted as intended to
 be granted unto them the said J B Wilson
 and John Sumner their heirs and assigns
 and to their only proper use and behoof for
 ever provided always nevertheless that if the
 said L D Doak and Lucinda Doak their
 heirs Executors or Administrators shall and
 do will and truly pay or cause to be paid unto
 the said M J Foster Executor of the last will
 and Testament of Thomas Smith the
 aforesaid note of six hundred and fifty Dollars
 on the day and time herein before mentioned
 and appointed thereof as by ather Lawful
 means keep harmless and indemnified the
 said J B Wilson and John Sumner their
 Executors and Administrators from the pay-
 ment of said note and all cost and charges
 as therein as aforesaid then and from thence
 for this present indenture shall save
 determine and become absolutely null and
 void any thing herein contained to the contrary
 notwithstanding In witness whereof we have
 hereunto set our hands and seals this the
 day and year first above written
