bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and
sell and convey unto the said Peter Dischazo the NW 1/4 of Sec 14 also East 1/2 of NE 1/4 and west 1/2 of SE 1/4 of Sec 15
all in Township 22 Range 3 West lying in Cahoon Valley in
said County of Shelby to have and to hold said lands to
him the said Peter Dischazo his heirs and assigns forever
Hereby Conveying all the right title and interest which the
said Samuel Bordon deceased did seized and possessed of
