This Deed made this the 9th day of February 1850 between James L Richardson
and his wife Catharine Richardson of the one part and Perry G Davis of the
other part Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of
one hundred dollars to me in hand paid the receipt is hereby
acknowledged I have bargained sold and conveyed
and by these Presents doth bargain sell & convey

unto the said Davis the following tract of land to wit the South East fourth of the North West fourth of Section four in Township Twenty four Range thirteen East lying and being in Shelby County Alabama & Tuscaloosa Land District together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold unto him the said Davis his heirs and assigns forever and I the said James L Richardson & Nathaniel Richardson for our selves his Executors and administrators unto him the said Davis do warrant and defend the claim and title of the above conveyed tract of land against all persons whomsoever In testimony whereof we hereunto set our hands & affix our seals in Conjunction the day and year above written.
