 March in the year of our Lord 1848 between A J
 Croft of the one part and O W Brantice Snow Borden
 & Sillegibee a Committee appointed by the Montevallo
 Lodge No 19 of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows
 Witnesseth that for the said Committee for and in
 consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to
 us in hand paid the receipt whereof we do hereby
 acknowledge have bargained and sold and by their
 privies do bargain sell and convey to the said
 A J Croft the South East half of lot no 49 the same
 now occupied by Hubbell Pierce lying in the Town
 Montevallo Shelby County Alabama to go with
 all and singular tenements Hereditaments and
 appurtenances therunto belonging an in any other
 appertaining unto him the said A J Croft his
 heirs executors administrators and assigns to

have and to hold the same in fee simple forever from
themselves the said community and their executors and from
all other persons whatsoever we will warrant and
power defend unto him the said A J Cropp as
