 21st of May in the year of our Lord and Thousand

 Bevil administrator of the Estate of Calvin
 Davis of the first part and Edward Flory of
 the second part both of the County of Shelby and
 State of Alabama Witnesseth that for and in
 consideration of the sum of Three hundred and
 fifty and dollars to me in hand paid by the
 said party of the second part the receipt where
 of is hereby acknowledged I Wyatt Bevil of the
 first part have bargained & sold and by these
 presents do bargain sell and deliver unto the

said Edward Flory his heirs Executors Administrator or assigns the following tract or parcel of Land to wit S $\frac{1}{4}$ of S $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5 Township 20 R 2 E The N $\frac{1}{4}$ of S $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5 Township 20 R 2 E - and the N $\frac{1}{4}$ of S $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8 Township 20 R 2 E all lying in the Land district of Tuscaloosa and containing 120 acres more or less - To have and to hold said land and premises with all the appurtenances therein to belonging or in any wise appertaining free and clear of all incumbrance whatsoever And I Wyatt Bevil of the first do hereby promise to warrant defend & forever defend unto the said Edward Flory of the second part his heirs or Representatives all such right & title to the above mentioned land In Testimony whereof with my hand and seal this day and date already mentioned
