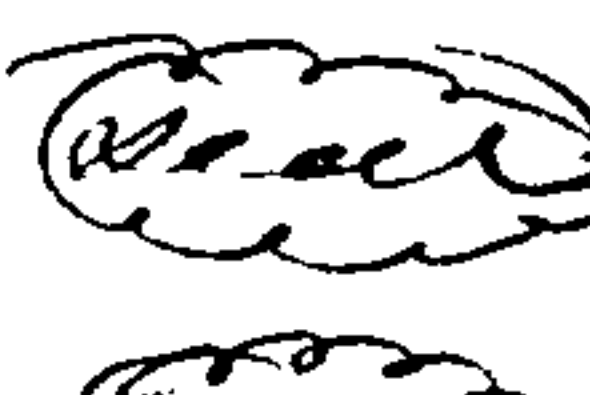
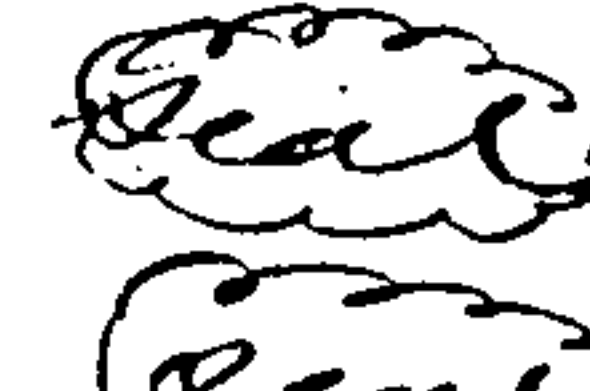


The State of Alabama } This deed of Trust made and
 Shelby County } entered in to this 6th day of Feb-
 -uary A.D. 1850 between Spencer
 Scarborough the debtor of the 1st part Branson McRay
 the Trustee of the 2nd part and Daniel McLeod the
 Creditor of the 3rd part all of said County Witnesseth
 that the said party of the 1st part is justly indebted
 to the said party of the 3rd part the sum of three
 hundred and twenty eight 28/100 dollars to be due 1st
 of January next as by a promissory note bearing
 even date herewith made by the party of the 1st
 to the party of the 3rd part will more fully appear
 which said debt the said party of the 1st part is
 anxious and desirous to secure to said party of the
 3rd part therefore for and in consideration of the
 promises as well for and in consideration of the
 sum of five dollars to him in hand paid by the
 party of the 2nd part the receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged the said party of the 1st part has
 given granted bargained and sold and by
 these presents do give grant bargain and sell to
 said party of the 2nd part the following named
 land lying in said County and known as follows
 to wit the NW 1/4 Sec 28 Township 20 Range and East
 also NW 1/4 Sec 33 Township 20 Range 1E and also
 the E 1/2 Sec 33 Township 20 Range and East
 and the following personal property to wit one
 road wagon and yoke and 2 horses 1 head of
 cattle and a wagon man slave named Adam &
 an spinning machine which said personal
 property is the same which is now in the hands
 of said Scarborough to have and hold said land
 and premises and personal property of
 said McRay & his Representatives forever upon

Trust nevertheless the said McRay is to permit the said Scarborough retain the peace possession of said land and personal property until default be made in the payment of the debt aforesaid, and until requested by said McLeod or his representatives upon which request the said McRay or his representatives may seize said land and personal property and the same sell to the highest bidder for cash first having given twenty days notice of the time and place of said sale by advertisement in at least three public places in said County and out of the proceeds of said sale pay said debt and the expenses of this Trust and the balance if any pay to said Scarborough but should the whole of said debt be paid by said Scarborough to said McLeod then this deed to be null and void else to remain in full force is

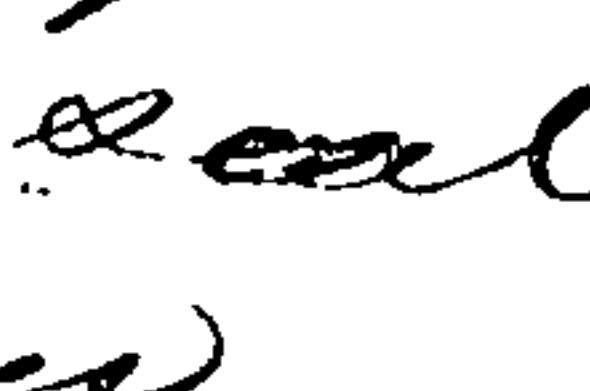
