promote does bargain sell convey and convey to the said Samuel Viers all that certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County aforesaid Harrison & described as follows to wit the South West fourth of South west fourth of section 35 fifth Township twenty and Range and East To have and to hold the above described land & premises with the tenements and appurtenances therewith belonging as in any wise appertaining unto the said Samuel Viers his heirs and assigns forever And the said Almonro Hall for his heirs executors and administrators does warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said Samuel Viers his heirs and assigns forever and against the said Hall and all and every person or persons claiming or holding under him the said Almonro Hall and also against the lawful title claim or demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever claiming or holding by from or under the Government of the United States In Testimony of which the said Almonro Hall has hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written Signed sealed and delivered Almonro Hall *Seal* in the presence of
