 January 1850 between Elijah
 Logan of the 1st part & Henry W. Robertson of the
 2nd part witnesseth that whereas Elijah Logan of the 1st
 part is indebted to H. W. Robertson as a promissory
 note for one hundred and sixty five Dollars due now & in order
 that the said Logan may fully secure the payment
 of said note to said Robertson the said Logan
 for and in consideration of the sum of one Dollar
 to him in hand paid has given granted bargained
 sold & sold and by these presents does give
 grant bargain & sell to said Robertson a

Certain tract or parcel of Land lying & being in the County & State aforesaid & Inclosed Land District known as the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 section 27 Township 21 Range 1 West also the crop of Corn & Cotton that said Logan may raise or cause to be raised upon said land this year to have & to hold said property to said Robertson & his heirs forever upon trust with respect & it is hereby expressly agreed and understood that said Logan is to retain possession of said property until the payment of the aforesaid sum of money has to be made then the said Robertson at once seized said property & take the same into his possession and proceed to sell the same to the highest bidder for cash first giving thirty days notice in at least three public places of the time & place of said sale & out of said sale pay said debt before expressed as well the expenses of this deed of trust and the balance if any pay over to said Logan but should the whole of said debt & expenses legally paid without injury or loss to said Robertson then this deed to be null and void & of no effect In testimony of which witness our hands & seals this 4th day of January A D 1850
