 of which is hereby acknowledged and of other good & valuable
 considerations we think Moving the said N. J. Harris have
 Bargained and sold and confirming unto the said Blasengame
 Osabors the following Land & property the West half of the
 S. West quarter of Section fifteen Township Twenty of Range
 Three West also South East fourth of the S. West fourth Except
 a part thereof lying North of Rock creek now inclosed by the
 lands of Masie & Childs extending to the Branch West of the
 North & South line in same Section Township & Range last
 mentioned, Also one log carriage & two yoke of Oxen together
 with the said mill and the proceeds of the same to have
 and to hold the above described land & property and effects
 to him & his heirs forever

The conditions of this conveyance
 is such that if the said N. J. Harris shall well and truly pay
 to the said Blasengame Osabors the sum of seven hundred
 dollars with all interest and cost & damages according to
 the tenor & effect of said note this conveyance to be void
 else to remain in full force and the said Blasengame Osabors
 shall at all times have power (after the maturity of said note)
 to take into possession and sell at Public sale after lawful
 notice the above described land & property for the purpose
 aforesaid given under my hand and seal this 28th
 day of February 1850.
