 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-

 other part witnesseth that the said James
 Bisley and Amanda Jane his wife for and
 in consideration of the sum of one hundred
 and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by
 the said Samuel J. Hale at and before the
 sealing and giving the receipt whereof they do
 hereby acknowledge by these presents have
 granted bargained sold aliened conveyed re-
 leased and confirmed and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell alien convey release and
 confirm unto the said Samuel J. Hale and
 to his heirs and assigns all their right
 title interest property claim and demand
 whatsoever of in to or into of a certain tract or

of Land situate and lying in the County of Shelby
 (to wit) The NW Corner of the South East fraction of
 Section Twenty four of Township 22 Range Three west
 containing 48 1/2 acres together with all and singular
 other the homs out houses buildings barns stables
 ways woods rights privileges hereditaments and appur-
 tenances what ever therunto belonging or in any
 wise appertaining to have and to hold the said
 tract or parcel of Land hereditaments and premises
 hereby Granted or mentioned or intended so to be
 with the appurtenances unto the Samuel J. Hale
 his heirs and assigns forever and the said James
 Busby for himself his heirs assigns Executors and
 administrators doth Covenant promise Grant and
 agree to and with the said Samuel J. Hale his
 heirs and assigns the said above mentioned and
 described messuage and tenement and tract of
 Land hereditaments and premises hereby Granted
 or mentioned or intended so to be with the appurte-
 nances unto the said Samuel J. Hale his heirs
 and assigns against him the said James Busby
 and his heirs and against all and every other
 persons or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming by
 force or under them or any of them shall and
 will warrant and defend forever by these presents
 In Witness where of we have hereunto set our
 hands & seals this eighteenth day of March A.D.

 known to her declared that she did voluntarily and
 of her free will and accord seal and as her act
 and deed deliver the said indenture without
 any coercion or compulsion of her husband
