 seized and possessed of a certain farm or piece of land situated &
 lying in the County of Shelly and State aforesaid and in the Tuscaloosa
 Land District. Known as follows to wit all that part of the West half
 of the South West quarter of Sec 28. that is lying South of the
 direction of a certain Crop fence known to designate J. J. J.
 Ovinton's Land & all of the South West q of Sec 29. except about
 3/4 of an acre that lies North of said Crop fence and also about
 thirty acres off of the end of the West half of said quarter
 divided Jack & David Ovinton and also a small fraction off
 of the East half of the North East quarter Sec 29 supposed
 to 200 acres more or less all in T 18 R E 1. With that in Consider
 ation of natural love and affection to our youngest son Henry
 Ovinton we do give and bequeath unto the said Henry Ovinton
 all our right title interest Estate demand and Claim for ever
 and the said Henry to take possession immediately after our
 decease to have and to hold the above described land & farm
 is for his sole and only use and benefit & to his heirs &
 assigns forever In testimony whereof we have hereunto
