 ents that Ira N Morgan of the County & State aforesaid and his
 Wife Milla Morgan for and in consideration of the sum of
 three hundred dollars to them in hand paid by John W Borman
 in the County & State of aforesaid at and before the sealing and
 delivery hereof the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and
 confirmed by these Presents do grant bargain sell release and con-
 firm unto the said John W Borman his heirs and assigns all their estate
 right title and demand whatsoever of in to or out of a certain
 tract or parcel of land situated on the West side of Morgan's
 Creek viz the West half of the North West quarter and all that
 part of the East half of North West quarter lying West of Morgan's
 Creek to being the Eastern boundary of said tract, in Section
 fifth Township Twenty & Range two East in the District of Tuscaloosa
 Co & State of Alabama containing One hundred and Twenty acres
 more or less together with all and single the hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining
 to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land to the only
 proper use and behoof of the said John W Borman his heirs
 administrators and assigns and the said Ira N Morgan &
 his wife doth hereby Covenant and agree to warrant & defend
 the title to the said John W Borman from all Claims whatever
 in future whereof we hereunto set our names and affix our
 seals the Eighteenth day of March ~~1848~~ Eighteen hundred and
 fifty eight signed sealed and delivered in Ira N Morgan Seal
