

The State of Alabama } This indenture made this 16th day of
 Shelby County } August eighteen hundred and fifty
 between James C. Arnett of the first
 part and Columbus Cunningham of the second part and
 Geo Sumner & Geo S Barnes of the third part all of
 the State and County above named volunthly that
 whereas the said James C. Arnett is indebted to M^r.
 Horton Adams of the State of Texas Arnett did in the
 sum of nine hundred and eighty seven dollars the
 sum being a promissory note dated Dec^r 6th eighteen
 hundred and forty nine and due two two months
 after date and whereas Geo Sumner and Geo S
 Barnes is securities to the above described note in
 & the said James C. Arnett have bargained sold
 aliened and conveyed and by these presents doth
 bargain sell alien and convey unto the said C
 Cunningham for and in Consideration of the sum
 of five dollars of lawful money to the said James C
 Arnett by the said C Cunningham in hand paid
 at and before making and delivering of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following
 described property to wit. One negro man named West David
 Completion about twenty nine years I James C. Arnett do
 for my self my heirs and assigns warrant and will we
 defend unto the said C Cunningham a good and lawful
 right to the said negro herein described against all and
 every person whatsoever in trust nevertheless should the
 said James C. Arnett pay or cause to be paid to the said
 M^r. Horton the note herein described on or before the 6th
 day of December eighteen hundred and fifty then this
 obligation to be void and of no effect but should the
 said James C. Arnett fail to pay the same on or before
 the sixth day of December next in that case the said C
 Cunningham may proceed to sell the property herein described
 at the town of Moundville first giving fifteen days notice and
 then the said Columbus Cunningham shall apply the proceeds
 to the payment of the note herein described and if there shall
 remain a balance in the hands of the said Cunningham arri-
 -ving from the sale of the within described property after
 paying the within described note then the said C Cunnin-
 -gham shall pay the same over to the said James C. Arnett
 after paying the expences of carrying this trust into effect
 Given under my hand and seal this the 16th day of August
 eighteen hundred and fifty J. C. Arnett (Seal)
