

The State of Alabama This instrument made this the 3^d day of
 Wholly County 3 August A D 1850 One thousand eight hundred
 and fifty between Thos L Pledger of the first part and John Sumner of the second part and Stray
 & Ulrich of the third parts Commercian Merchants in Mobile
 all of the State & Court above named witnesseth that whereas
 the said Thos L Pledger is indebted to the said Stray & Ulrich
 in the sum of five hundred dollars in money advanced in
 Mobile \$500.00 The sum being due and unpaid dated Febru-
 ary the 1st 1850 & the said Thos L Pledger has bargained &
 sold a Lian and Bawdy and by these presents doth bargain
 sell a Lian and Bawdy with the said John Sumner for
 and in consideration of the sum of five dollars in lawful
 money Paid to the said Thos L Pledger by the said John
 Sumner in hand paid at and before sealing and
 delivering these presents the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
 knowledged the following described property to wit the
 present and future planted and growing Crop of Cotton
 & Corn at the plantation and premises known as Thos L
 Pledger the same lying in the County and State above
 named It being understood that the same shall
 yield of Cotton Twenty thousand pounds and of Corn
 six hundred bushels both of which Crops are to be picked
 and Gathered by the said Thos L Pledger & Thos L Pledger
 do for my self my heirs and assigns warrant and well
 warrant unto the said John Sumner a Good and
 Lawful right to the property herein described against
 all and every person what soever In trust however &
 That should the said Thos L Pledger pay or cause to be
 paid to the said Stray & Ulrich said amount of
 money herebefore described on or before the 1st day
 of January A D 1851 then this obligation to be void
 and of no effect but should the said Thos L Pledger
 fail to pay the sum on or before the 1st day of
 January A D 1851 in that case the said John

may proceed to sell the property herein described at
 such time and place as he may think proper
 Giving due and lawful notice and then the said
 John Sumner shall apply the proceeds to the pay-
 -ment of the said debt herein described and if there
 should remain a balance in the hands of the said
 John Sumner arising from the sale of the within
 described property then the said John Sumner shall
 pay the surplus over to the said Thos L Pledger
 after paying the expenses of carrying this trust into effect
 Given under our hands & seals this the 3rd day of August
 A D 1850. Thos L Pledger
