 of the natural love and affection which I have for my son
 John G. Walton of said County in whose family I now
 reside and have resided since the fall of A.D. 1840. and whom
 I expect to reside during my natural life and for and in
 Consideration that my said son the said John G. Walton
 has been kind to me kept and supported me for
 the time last aforesaid during a good portion of
 which time I have been helpless and unable to help
 myself and whereas said John G. Walton promises that he
 will support me during my natural life and in case I
 survive him that his family will do so, therefore for
 and in Consideration of the promises aforesaid I have
 given granted bargained and sold and by these Presents
 do give grant bargain and sell to said John G. Walton
 and to his heirs forever a negro bay slave of English
 complexion called Marion about nineteen years of
 age, now or late also my bay horse the only one I
 own my trunk - bed - & shot gun to have and hold
 the said slave and other property to said John G. Walton
 & his heirs forever and I the said Thomas Walton do
 covenant to wit with the said John G. Walton that I
 am lawfully seized of the property aforesaid and that
 I will forever warrant and defend titles to said John G.
 Walton and his heirs forever to which I hereby
 bind my self my heirs and representatives for
 ever In Witness of which I set my hand and
 seal this the 5th day of October A.D. 1858
