 Christophor Salses of the County and State
 aforesaid are held and firmly bound to George
 and Susannah Salses husband and wife of the
 County of Bibb and State aforesaid in the sum
 of eight thousand dollars to the payment of which
 will and truly to be done I bind myself
 my heirs executors and administrators jointly
 and severally firmly by these presence Sealed with
 my seal and date the 1st day of October 1850
 The Condition of the above obligation is such that

If the above bound Christopher Salser shall will and truly do execute and perform every and thing necessary for the Comfort support and maintenance of the above named George and Susannah Salser for and during their natural life and in case they or either of them survive him: That his heirs and representatives do the same and also that he the said Christopher Salser his heirs and representatives will redeliver to said George and Susannah Salser as a loan Lydia a negro woman of dark complexion about fifty or fifty two years of age Charles a negro man of dark complexion about twenty two years of age Jason a negro boy about ten years old dark complexion Jacob a negro boy yellow complexion about ten years old and Metta a negro girl dark complexion about eight or nine years of age and also such of the house hold and kitchen furniture Stock of horses Cattle Ovens hogs Sheep cows and tools as they may desire the same which they have this day conveyed and delivered to me said Christopher Salser and return the same at their pleasure during their natural life then this obligation to be well and void dec. to remain in full force witness my hand and seal as aforesaid
