of the North west quarter of Section Three in Town-
ship Twenty of Range one west in the district
of land subject to sale at Tusculooa Alabama
Containing thirty nine acres more or less and being
the place on which John^W Willson use to live to have
and hold the same forever the party of the first
do Covenant with the party of the 2nd part That I
Will forever warrant and defend title in fee simple
to him and his heirs forever to said land witness my
