-ed granted sold aliened enfeoffed and conveyed and by their presents do bargain sell enfeoff and convey to the said J Mc McClannahan all the certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama and known and distinguished in the plan of survey of said State as the South East fourth of the South East fourth of Section 18 Township 2 N Range 13 East

To Have and to hold the above described tract or of Land together with the tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertain-
-ing unto the said Mc McClannahan his heirs and assigns forever and the said George & Nancy Crim for their heirs executors and administrators do warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said Mc McClannahan his heirs and assigns from and against us and all and every person or persons claiming or holding under us the said Crim & wife and also against the lawful title claim or demand of all and every person or persons whosoever claiming or holding by from or under the government of the United States in testimony whereof the said Crim & wife have hereunto set their hand and seal the day and year above written.
