

✓ This Indenture made this 19th day of December one thousand eight hundred and fifty between Thomas Jefferson Stand of the County of Shelby in the State of Alabama of the one part and James C Stand of the other part Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in Consideration of the sum of Two hundred & sixty five dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has this day bargained granted sold aliened enfeoffed and Conveyed and by these presents does bargain sell enfeoff and Convey to the said James C Stand All that Certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama and known and distinguished in the plan of Survey of said Cty as the West half of the South West quarter of Section 13 Township 21 Range 2 West and the South East fourth of the South East fourth of Section 18 14 Township 21 Range 2 West To have and to Hold the above described tracts or parcels of Land together with the tenements and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said J C Stand his heirs and assigns forever And the said Thomas Jefferson Stand for himself his heirs executors and administrators does warrant and will forever defend the title to the above described and hereby granted premises unto the said James C Stand his heirs and assigns forever and against him and all and every person or persons claim or holding under him the said J C Stand and also against the lawful title claim or demand of all and every person or persons Whosoever claiming or holding by from or under the Government of the United States In Testimony whereof the said Thomas Jefferson Stand has hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above Written
