 Arthur Robertson of the one part and Daniel Gardner

of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Gardner has become the security of the said Robertson to R R Rushing & H H Sawyer admors of B Rushing & Co for the sum of sixty four 50/100 dollars or thereabouts by note to be due Jan'y 1852 which said Gardner said Robertson is anxious and desirous to secure and hold harmless therefore for and in Consideration of the promises as well for and in Consideration of the further sum of one dollar in hand paid the said Robertson has and does hereby sell and Convey to said Gardner a yoke of Oxen and sorrell Colt the same now in the possession of said Robertson to hold for as the said Robertson retain the possession of the same until default be made in the payment of the debt aforesaid when so soon thereof the same becomes due the said Gardner may seize & take said Sturs & Colt and the same advertise for twenty days - and sell the same in Columbiana to the highest bidder for Cash and the same as so much thereof as is necessary pay to said admors in discharge of said debts & Costs hereof but should the same be fully paid on its becoming due by said Robertson then this deed of trust to be void A.
