

This Indenture made and entered into this tenth day of
 December Eighteen hundred and fifty William Harkins
 and Gillian Harkins his wife of the County of Shelby and
 State of Alabama of the one part and John Harkins of

 that the said William and Gillian Harkins for and in
 Consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars to them
 in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 and hath this day bargained and sold and by their
 heirs and assigns doth bargain and sell unto the said John

Harkins all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Shelby and State of Alabama and Known as the east half of the North east quarter Section eight Township Twenty two Range two west in the District of Land subject to Sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama Containing eighty acres more or less together with all and singular the appurtenances heretofore and Rights in any wise appertaining unto the said John Harkins his heirs and assigns forever and the said William and Zillia Harkins for themselves their heirs Executors and Administrators doth warrant & will ever defend the right and title to the above and hereby Conveyed premises unto the said John Harkins his heirs and assigns forever and against the Claim of them the said William and Zillia Harkins and all and every person or persons Claiming or holding under or by the said William and Zillia Harkins and also against the lawful title Claim or claim of all and every person or persons whomsoever Claiming or holding by or from under the General Government of the United States of Alabama Witness our hands and seals the day and date above written
