A D 1850 between John P. West the debtor of the 1st part  
David W. Leoldwell the Trustee of the 2nd part John  
Shinner and John McLellan and the Creditors of  
the 3rd part witness that whereas the parties

of the third part on the securities of the part of the 1<sup>st</sup>  
part to R.R. Rushing & E.H. Sawyer administrators of the  
Estate of B. Rushing died on a note for the sum  
of Eleven hundred and ninety one dollars dated  
18<sup>th</sup> Novr 1850 and due 1 January 1852 which said  
securities said West is desirous and anxious to pos-  
ticipate and hold himself therefor for and in consideration  
of the promises as well for and in consideration of the  
sum of five dollars to him in hand paid by

~~Trustee as aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged the said West has given granted bargained  
and sold and by these presents doth grant  
bargain and sell to said D.W. Goldwell the following pro-  
perty to wit Isaac about eight years old and  
Anna a girl about 8 years old & George a man about 30  
years old to have and hold the same forever in trust the  
said John P. West is to hold the quiet & uninterrupted  
possession of said property until default be made in  
the payment of said debt to said Rushing and Sawyer  
and shall bequeath by said Sumner or McLanahan  
as either of them representatives when the said Trustee as  
aforesaid shall and may see fit and take said property  
and the same sell in Columbia and for Cash to the  
highest bidder first giving twenty days notice in those  
public places in said County of the time and place  
of said sale and out of the proceeds of said sale  
pay and satisfy said debt before described and  
the overplus if any pay over to said West but  
should the said debt be paid without the said  
Sumner & McLanahan being made to suffer less  
than this deed to be void else to remain in full  
force witness our hands and seals~~
