Truster as aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said West has given granted bargain-
ed and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell to said J W Coldwell the following personal property to wit Isaac about eight years old a girl about 8 years old & George a man about 30 years old to have and hold the same forever in trust the said John P West is to hold the quiet & uninterrupted possession of said property until default be made in the payment of said debt to said Rushing and Sawyer and until requested by said Summer or McLanahan or either of their representatives when the said Truster as aforesaid shall and may seize and take said property and the same sell in Columbia for cash to the highest bidder first giving twenty days notice in those public places in said County of the time and place of said sale and out of the proceeds of said sale pay and satisfy said debt before described and the surplus if any pay over to said West but should the said debt be paid without the said Summer & McLanahan being made to suffer less than this deed to be void else to remain in full force Witness our hands and seals
